On September 17<sup>th</sup>, 2011, hundreds of thousands of volunteers will participate in the Ocean Conservancy's International Coastal Cleanup, the world's largest volunteer event of its kind. Last year over 500,000 volunteers from 114 countries and 45 states cleared over 8 million pounds of trash from oceans and waterways and recorded every piece of trash collected.
